CONTENT OF THE COURSE

We will work with oral and written comprehension and expression in Spanish, the development of skills to encourage a first approach to Spanish as a foreign language and work in multicultural and multilingual contexts.

2. The verbs ser, estar, tener, haber, ir.
3. Demonstratives.
4. Interrogative verbs.
5. Adjectives and agreement.
6. Possessives.
7. Pronouns.
8. Coordinated sentences.
9. Time, place, circumstance: adverbs.
10. Subordinate sentences

METHODOLOGY

Theoretical-practical methodology with lectures to establish the fundamentals of the subject and practical workshops in which students build their own learning. In addition, oral and written work and assignments will be developed, individually and in groups, with exams that allow to know, in an objective way, the degree of knowledge of the student.
