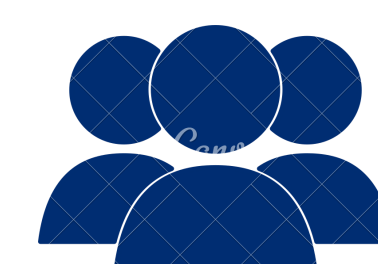

## SYSTEM OF CREDITS

ECTS – European Credit Transfer System:  
1 credit = 25 hours



- The ECTS system improves the flexibility of study programmes for students and allows credits obtained at one higher education institution to be computed towards a qualification studied at another, therefore representing learning based on defined learning outcomes and their associated workload.
- The ECTS system is based on two main aspects:
  - Information about study programmes and student's achievements.
  - Mutual agreement between partner institutions and the student.
- 60 ECTS credits are equivalent to a full academic year and 30 ECTS credits are equivalent to one academic term.
